

SHELTON, CLAUDE LEROY

May 26, 1923-April 23, 1950

Funeral services for a 26 year old sailor, Claude LeRoy Shelton, were held Sunday at the Schrader funeral home, with Mr. C.E. Henry in charge.

Shelton, who was on leave from the Memphis Naval Base, Memphis, Tenn., was killed instantly in a head-on crash with a large semi-freighter truck at Concordia, Mo. A veteran of World War II, he had just purchased a new car.

He is survived by his father, Paul Shelton of Pond Creek, Okla., and a cousin, Glenn Notman of Hamilton, Mont.

With military services at the graveside, he was buried in the Wheatland cemetery near the burial plot of his mother who passed away 24 years ago.

The pallbearers, Claude Gibson, Don Craven, Robert Craven, Louis Lowry, Glen Lowry and William Johnson, were classmates of his at Huntley, Wyoming, where he had lived with his cousins, the Glenn Notmans, following his mother's death.
