

George P. Shepard

Funeral services for George Perry Shepard were held Thursday, May 31, 1979, at 10:30 a.m. at the First Christian Church with Rev. Sidney Hoadley officiating. George died Monday in Wheatland. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements.

Shepard was born Dec. 28, 1958 in Kimball, Neb., the son of Willard and Louise Steinmark Shepard. He lived with his family in Pine Bluffs until they moved to Cheyenne and later to Rocky Ford, Colo.

The family moved to Wheatland ten years ago and he had been employed as a carpenter with various contractors in this

area. He had also been associated with C and S Railroad and most recently with Harvey Farms in Slater.

During his school years, George was very active in wrestling and had won first place in a Junior High School wrestling meet here in Wheatland.

He is survived by his father, Willard Shepard of Guernsey; his mother, Louise Shepard of Wheatland; a brother, Will Shepard of Wheatland; and a sister, Tamra Wilhelm of Wheatland.
