

SHEPARD, HULDA AKERBLADE

March 24, 1876-April 22, 1936

Mrs. P.A. Shepard, Sr., well known and loved resident of this community for many years, passed away at her home on the East Wheatland Flats at 2:45 p.m. Wednesday, April 22. Although she had been in poor health for some time, her death came suddenly, after an acute illness of only a few hours.

Mrs. Shepard was born at Osceola, Nebr., March 24, 1876 and reached the age of sixty years and twenty-eight days at the time of her demise.

Another long-time resident of Wyoming, Mrs. Shepard came to this state forty years ago, as a young girl of twenty years ago, and had lived in this community since that time.

Besides her husband, Mrs. Shepard is survived by three sons; Peter W., Tommy R. and Lloyd A., all of Wheatland; two daughters, Mrs. F.W. Hudson of Loma, Colo., and Mrs. A.D. Smith of Kettle Falls, Wash.; two sisters, Mrs. Chas. Randall of Wheatland and Mrs. Hannah Johnson of Hershey, Nebr., and one brother, Charlie Akerblade of LaGrange, Wyo. Several of the out of town relatives are expected here for the funeral.

Rev. Williams will conduct the funeral services from the Methodist church on Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
