

SHERWOOD, HERMAN ROY

March 21, 1898-April 1, 1987

Graveside services for Roy Sherwood were held Monday, April 6, 1987, at 10:30 A.M. in the Wheatland Cemetery with Chet Shaw officiating. Mr. Sherwood died April 1, 1987 in Houston where he had been making his home with a son.

Herman Sherwood was born March 21, 1898 in Hallam, Neb., the son of David and Mary (Axthelm) Sherwood. After he came to Wyoming he and Viola Hoffman were married on her family ranch Dec. 1, 1918. The couple moved to Nebraska where they were engaged in farming for 10 years.

In the 1920's they returned to Wheatland and purchased what is now the City Farm. In 1944 they sold that and moved to the Gladys Preuit acreage which is presently operated by their son. They moved to California where Herman was an electronics inspector with an aircraft company. In 1975 they returned to Wheatland to spend their retirement years. Mrs. Sherwood died in 1985.

Survivors include four sons: Barton Sherwood of Houston, Homer Sherwood of Medford, Ore., Roland Sherwood of Wheatland, James Sherwood of New Berg, Ore.; three sisters; Ruth Robbins of Wheatland, Betty Carey of Douglas, Shirley Sellers of Denver, and 21 grandchildren and several great-grandchildren.

A memorial in his name has been established to the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing.
