

SHINN, GUY
February 4, 1872-August 28, 1958

Guy Shinn, resident of this community since 1924, passed away at the Platte County Memorial hospital on Thursday, August 28 following an extended illness.

Born February 4, 1872 near Leon, in Decatur County, Iowa, he was the last remaining survivor of the twelve children of Wesley Shinn and Asenath Melbina Reece Shenn. He grew up on a farm in Decatur County, where, after the death of his father, he helped care for his mother and blind sister, Alice. In 1916, he came to Wyoming, homesteading 25 west of Wheatland with his brothers, Willis, Charles and Walter. He later moved to an irrigated farm southwest of Wheatland which he purchased.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday, August 30 at 2 p.m. from the Schrader Funeral chapel, with Irvin Noyce the officiating minister.

Survivors include a nephew, Howard S. Pine of Castle Rock, Colo. and two nieces, Mrs. C. H. Mitchell of Cincinnati, Ia. And Mrs. Wayne Hite of Garden grove, Calif.

Pallbearers were Tom Tugman, Lester Short, Owen Short, Harold Billings, Frank Kuehner, and Ted Shaffner. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
