November 16, 1882-January 1, 1969

William Henry Shoemaker, a resident of Wheatland for the past 56 years, passed away on Jan. 1, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after an extended illness. Funeral services were conducted Friday, Jan. 3, at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel by Rev. Henry Hartberg. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
