

10-30 Charles Louis Short 1987

Services for Charles Louis Short, 70, who died in Wheatland Oct. 30, 1987, were held Monday, Nov. 2, 1987, at 10:30 a.m. in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Pastor Delbert Dick officiating.

Born Jan. 31, 1917, in Lakeview, he was the son of Lester and Mabel (Sanderson) Short. He attended school in the Veteran area and worked various ranches and farms prior to joining the U.S. Army in 1941. He served in North Africa, Sicily and Italy. Upon being discharged in 1944 he came to Wheatland where he started farming.

He and Kathryn Norvell were married Nov. 26, 1949, in Scottsbluff, Neb. He drove a milk truck for Mountain Empire for 20 years until his retirement in 1982.

Survivors include 4 brothers: Kenneth and Owen Short, both of Wheatland, James Short of Cheyenne, Ben Short of Edmond, Okla.; 2 sisters: Clara Angle of Fort Collins and Edna Martin of Cheyenne.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his wife in 1985.
