

Lester Short

Funeral services for Lester Short are scheduled for Friday, June 1, 1979, at 10:30 a.m. at the United Church of Christ with Rev. Gordon Grant officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Lester Short passed away Monday at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland at the age of 89.

He was born May 1, 1890 in Kansas. In 1913 he married Mable Sanderson and they came to Wyoming in a covered wagon

to homestead in the Goshen Hole area. They farmed in Goshen Hole for many years and then moved to the Wheatland area where he operated a farm until the time of his retirement.

He is survived by his wife, Mable of Wheatland; five sons, Charles, Kenneth, and Owen of Wheatland, James of Cheyenne and Ben of San Antonio, Tex.; two daughters, Clara Angle and Edna Martin, both of Cheyenne; two brothers, Mel Short of Wheatland and Dan Short of
