

SHORT, MABLE FLORENCE SANDERSON

July 3, 1894-October 18, 1984

Services for Mable Florence Short, 90, who died in Wheatland, Oct. 18, were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel Monday, Oct. 22 at 2 p.m. with Dan Barcus officiating.

She was born in Norton, Kan. July 3, 1894, the daughter of Lewis and Clara Sanderson. In 1913, she and Lester Short were married in Kansas and came to Wyoming in a covered wagon to homestead in Goshen Hole.

The family moved to Wheatland in 1936 and farmed here. Mr. Short passed away in 1979.

Mrs. Short has spent the last fourteen months in the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Home.

Survivors include five sons: Charles Short, Kenneth Short and Owen Short, all of Wheatland; Ben Short of Edmond, Oklahoma and James Short of Cheyenne; also two daughters, Clara Angle and Edna Martin, both of Cheyenne; 18 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren.

Besides her husband, she was preceded in death by one sister, Edna Myers and one grandchild.

A memorial has been established in her name to the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
