

SHUFFLEBARGER, CHARLES O.

July 14, 1909-December 31, 1985

Services for Charles (Blue) Shufflebarger, 76, who died in Wheatland Dec. 31, 1985, were held Thursday, Jan. 2, 1986, in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home at 2:00 P.M. with Pastor Virgil Lamm officiating.

Charles Shufflebarger was born in Casper, July 14, 1909, the son of Roy and Maude Shufflebarger. He worked at the Two Bar Ranch out of Casper until 1941.

He moved to Bremerton, Wash. in 1942 and worked at Puget Sound Navy Yards as a welder until early 1946. At that time he moved to a farm and ranch combination 20 miles southwest of Wheatland where he lived until the time of his death.

He also worked as a welder from 1949 until his retirement in 1975. He was a member of the Plumbers and Pipefitters Union Local 193 in Casper. He and Ruth Cozad were married January 27, 1938.

Survivors include his wife, Ruth of Wheatland, one son, Charles C. Shufflebarger of Durango, Colo., and two granddaughters.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two sisters.
