Funeral services for Ruth Irene Shufflebarger, 75, were Saturday September 25 at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Shufflebarger died Wednesday, September 22, 1993 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Ruth was the daughter of Henry Clinton and Elsie (Fisher) Cozad, born February 25, 1913, in Freedom, Nebraska. The family moved to the Chugwater area from Nebraska in 1922 and Ruth received her education in the Chugwater area. She married Charles Oliver Shufflebarger in 1938 in Gering, Nebraska. During World War II they moved to Washington state where Mr. Shufflebarger was a welder in a Navy shipyard. After the war, they returned to Wyoming and the Wheatland area. Ruth enjoyed gardening and was an avid Cowboy fan.

Ruth is survived by a son, Charles C. Shufflebarger of Kekaha, Hawaii; a sister, Garnett Larson of Wheatland; a brother, Gerald Cozad of Cheyenne; and two granddaughters, Maile Shufflebarger of Boulder, Colorado, and Heather Shufflebarger of Koloa, Hawaii.

She was preceded in death by her parents; and husband on December 31, 1985.
