

Stanley Lewis Sickels

Funeral services for Stanley Lewis Sickels, 82, were held Wednesday, Jan. 2, at 10 a.m., at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Howard Bradbury, Bishop, officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Stanley Sickels died Dec. 27, 1990, at the Wyoming Medical Center in Casper.

He was born May 27, 1908, at Orleans, Neb., where he was reared and educated. In 1935 he came to Wheatland and worked for several ranches in the area.

In April of 1942, he joined the U.S. Army and served until July, 1943. After his discharge, he returned to Wheatland. He was married to Betty Locke, who died on Nov. 9, 1966. In April, 1969, he married Jessie Locke, who died in April, 1976.

He had remained in the Wheatland area since his discharge from the service, working as a farmer. He retired in 1987.

He is survived by one daughter, Suzanna Millhouse of Angola, Ind., and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two wives.
