

SLAGLE, EDWARD THOMAS
May 29, 1899-May 23, 1976

Funeral services for Edward Thomas Slagle will be held Wednesday, May 26, 1976 at the Schrader-Prell Chapel 2:00 p.m. Rev. Gordon Tritchler will conduct the services. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Slagle died Monday, May 23, 1976 by accidental drowning at the age of 76. He was born in Breckenridge, Mo. May 29, 1899. A retired telegraph operator for Union Pacific Railroad, he had lived in Wheatland since March of this year. He had been a member of the Cheyenne community from 1922 to 1950 when he moved to San Diego, Calif.

He was a member of Consistory #3 Laramie Lodge and a past member of the Elks #582-Laramie.

In death he is survived by a son, John of Wheatland; three daughters, Mrs. Dick (Rosemary) Jones, Mrs. Richard (Dorothy) Bradley, Mrs. Eugene (Jeannine) Bailey, all of Cheyenne; one sister, Georgia Bennett of Breckenridge, Mo.; 16 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren. Three brothers and one sister preceded him in death.
