

SMITH, GEORGE OTTO  
February 17, 1893-April 17, 1959

Funeral services were conducted from the Schrader Chapel Monday at 2:00 p.m. for George Otto Smith, who died suddenly from a heart attack April 17, 1959, at the Hank Mowrey farm, 60 miles northeast of Wheatland. Rev. John Daly officiated at the last rites.

Mr. Smith was born in Jerico Springs, Missouri, on April 17, 1959, and had resided in the Glendo community since 1914. He was a retired rancher and a veteran of World War I.

He is survived by one brother, James W. Smith of Farmington, New Mexico and one sister, Mrs. Charles H. Robinson of Cody.

Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery with pallbearers being John Weimer, LaVerne Robinson, V.C. Robinson, Henry Mowrey, Ivan VanBuskirk and Malcolm Hammer.
