August 25, 1913-July 13, 1981

Robert Darrel "Tiny" Smith, 67, died Monday, July 13, 1981 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Tiny, the son of Walter H. and Eva D. Ross Smith, was born Aug. 25, 1913 in Pulaski County, Mo. He moved with his family to South Dakota, and from there they moved Wheatland. He has resided here the past 33 years. He worked for Wyoming State Highway Department for 22 years as an operator. He served in arm services during World War II. He was a member of the VFW, Laramie Peak Post No. 3558 and Wheatland Moose Lodge No. 1636, and the Wheatland Volunteer Fire Department.

He is survived by three nephews, Gary Smith of Watertown, Wis., John Lieb of Cheyenne, and Larry Lieb of Jerseyville, Ill.; and one niece, Geraldine Elflin of Elm Hurst, Ill.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Keith, Donald and Kenneth; and two sisters, Evelyn Lieb and Katherine Grothman.
