

SMITH, SAMUEL H.

March 26, 1891-June 3, 1968

Funeral services for Samuel H. Smith, Dwyer, who died at the V.A. Hospital in Cheyenne Monday, June 3, after an illness of several weeks, were held this morning (Thursday) from the Schrader Chapel at 10:30. Rev. Ralph Martin officiated and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with military honors. Pallbearers were James Valentine, Ralph Blunck, Roger Mills, Richard Chase, Carl Rutherford and George Bowman.

Mr. Smith was born in Acheson, Kans. Mar. 26, 1891. He was a Torrington resident before moving to Platte county in 1952 where he operated a junkyard until his retirement. He was married in Casper to Viola Walker who survives him. He was a veteran of World War I serving in the U.S. Army. He was affiliated with the Baptist church, Cottonwood, Pomona, and State Granges.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Ameda Mason, Wichita, Kans., and Mrs. Elsie Pryor, Los Angeles, Calif.
