

SMITH, WALTER H.

March 9, 1865-September 18, 1931

Walter H. Smith, for years a prominent citizen and real estate dealer in Platte county, passed away at his home September 18, at the age of 66 years, 6 months and 10 days. He had been in failing health for the past three years, caused from pneumonia, which left his heart in a weakened condition and for the past three weeks had been confined to his home.

The deceased was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Smith and was born March 9<sup>th</sup>, 1865 at Rockford, Ill. He received his elementary education in Bon Homme county, South Dakota and graduated from a business college in Mitchell, S. Dak.

He was united in marriage to Eva D. Ross, November 11<sup>th</sup>, 1901. He leaves his wife, six children, two brothers and a sister to mourn his passing. The children are: Donald who lives in Colorado, Katherine, Kenneth, Darrell, Evelyn and Keith, all of Wheatland.

Funeral services were held from the Congregational church Sunday afternoon with the Rev. R.E. Morgan preaching the funeral sermon and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery by the Longwith-Richards Funeral Home.
