

SOMMERS, MINA C. HARPER
December 3, 1873-December 5, 1941

Mrs. Mina Sommers, 68, resident of Wyoming since 1898, died at the Memorial hospital in Cheyenne Friday, after a brief illness.

Mrs. Sommers was the widow of the late Charles Sommers who died in 1929. She was born in Crawfordsville, Iowa December 3, 1873. She was united in marriage on November 2, 1891 in Crawfordsville, and came to Wyoming with Mr. Sommers in 1898. Until the time of his death, they lived on a ranch in the Sybille region southwest of Wheatland.

She was the mother of 12 children, 11 of whom survive, including Mrs. Lawrence Peters of Detroit, Mich.; Mrs. John McSorley, Mrs. A.C. Wright, Mrs. Karl Perry, Joe and Tom Sommers, all of Cheyenne; Hall Sommers, Hartville, Don Sommers, Glendo; Phifer and Jack Sommers, Portland, Ore. and Mrs. Ivory Royce of Wheatland. Twenty-two grandchildren and two great grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Monday from the Wheatland Methodist church, with Rev. C.B. Doughty in charge. Interment was made beside her husband in the Wheatland cemetery.
