

SOUTHARD, HENRY ALLAN
April 11, 1923-October 6, 1958

Henry Allan Southard, 35, of Guernsey, was killed Monday, Oct. 6, when a crane he was operating on a highway construction job, sixteen miles west of Cheyenne, overturned. He was employed by Riedsel-Lowe Construction Co.

Mr. Southard was born in Ft. Lyons, Colo., April 11, 1923. He was a member of the American Legion, V.F.W. and a veteran of World War II.

He is survived by his wife, Mildred; one son, Michael Henry of Encampment; one daughter, Sally Marie, also of Encampment; his mother, Mrs. Freda Southard, Guernsey; three brothers, Jack of Pontiac, Mich., L.W.
