

SPAHN, CHARLOTTE SCHMIDT

August 1, 1894-August 21, 1963

Mrs. Charlotte Spahn, 69, a former resident of Wheatland, died suddenly August 21 at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Marilyn Underbrink of Casper.

She was born August 1, 1894 in Russia and came to this country as a small child. She was married November 11, 1914 in Hastings, Nebr. to David Spahn.

The family lived in Scottsbluff, Nebr. and Wheatland vicinities until Mr. Spahn's death in August 1943. Since that time, Mrs. Spahn has made her home with Mrs. Underbrink and another daughter, Mrs. Betty Taylor of Warwick, Va.

Mrs. Spahn was a member of the Temple Baptist Church of Newport News, Va.

Other survivors include a third daughter, Mrs. Mildred Hain of Wellington, Colo.; two sons, Milton of Corpus Christi, Tex. and Robert of Kelso, Wash.; three sisters, Mrs. Mary Schmidt and Mrs. Katherine Mohrlang, both of Scottsbluff and Mrs. Anna Mohrlang of Hastings; one brother, George Schmidt of Cincinnati, Ohio and 17 grandchildren and one great grandson.

Funeral services were held at 10:00 a.m. at the Horstman Memorial Chapel in Casper and graveside services and interment at the Wheatland cemetery at 2:00 p.m.
