

SPAHN, DAVID

November 30, 1893-August 4, 1943

David Spahn, 50, who made his home on a farm three miles southeast of Wheatland for the past year and a half, died at the Wheatland hospital at two o'clock Wednesday morning following a stroke sustained at his home the previous morning.

Mr. Spahn, who was born November 30, 1893, in Russia, and his family has made their home in this community for nine years at one time, and returned here from Scottsbluff a year and a half ago. He was affiliated with the First Baptist Church of Scottsbluff.

He leaves his wife, Charlotte, three daughters, Mrs. Archie Hain of Scottsbluff, and Betty and Marilyn at home; two sons, Milton of the U.S. Army, now stationed in New Orleans, and Robert at home; four brothers; three sisters and two grandchildren.

Funeral rites will be held Friday afternoon at two o'clock from the Schrader chapel, with the Rev. Harry Allen of the Wheatland Baptist church officiating.
