Stella Spence died Friday, Nov. 26, 1982 at the Mt. Towers Nursing Home in Cheyenne at the age of 71 years.

She was born April 24, 1911 in Brush, Colo., the daughter of Newell and Martha Ragsdale. She attended school and received her education in Brush.

She met and married W.B. Spence and the couple moved to Wheatland where he became associated with the Platte County Record, a local newspaper. In the 1940s, the couple moved to Torrington where William worked for the newspaper there.

They returned to Wheatland in the mid-1950s and made their home here until William died in 1968.

She had been a resident at Mt. Towers Nursing Home in Cheyenne in recent years.

She was a charter member of the VFW Auxiliary and the American Legion Auxiliary in Wheatland. She is survived by one son, Don Trueblood of Bonners Ferry, Idaho; six sisters, and four grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one brother.

Funeral services were held Monday, Nov. 29, 1982 at 2 p.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Rev. Ken Saunders officiating. Burial was in the family plot in the Wheatland Cemetery.
