Services for June Carol Spievak, 59, began with graveside services on Saturday, June 22 at 10 a.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery with Reverend Linda Patzke officiating.

The ceremony was followed by a memorial service at the Wheatland United Methodist Church at 10:30 a.m.

June died Sunday, June 16 at the emergency room of the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.
