

STANFORD, FRANCES RUTH

May 26, 1917-June 2, 1936

Mrs. Fred Searle of Glendo received a telephone call Monday, June 2, telling of the death of her niece, Miss Frances Ruth Stanford, at Earhart, Kans., on that same day.

Miss Stanford was born in Wheatland, May 26, 1917, having reached the age of nineteen little more than a week before her death, which was caused by rheumatic fever. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Ted Stanford, who made their home in Wheatland for many years. Mr. Stanford operated a garage here.

After leaving Wheatland, the Stanfords moved to Glendo and from there to Johnstown, Colo. Miss Stanford graduated from the Johnstown high school last year, and was the honor student of her class. Last winter she attended business college in Denver.

A short time ago, Mr. and Mrs. Stanford and Miss Stanford left Johnstown for Kansas, thinking the change might benefit the health of Mr. Stanford, who is seriously ill at this time. Details of Miss Stanford's death are not known, but was unexpected and must have come suddenly.

Besides her parents and aunt, Mrs. Searle, Miss Stanford is survived by one brother, Bob, and one sister, Mrs. Clara Teel of Johnstown.

Mr. and Mrs. Fred Searle and family passed thru Wheatland Tuesday night on their way to the funeral of Miss Stanford.

A telegram received by the W.B. Forwood family, stated the remains of Miss Stanford were being brought to Wheatland tomorrow, but as the time of arrival is indefinite, no funeral arrangements have as yet been made. The Copley Funeral Home will be in charge of these last rites.
