Services for Charles Stanker, 73, who died in Cheyenne Feb. 26, 1983, were held March 1 in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Father John Murray officiating.

Charles Stanker was born in Creighton, Nebr., Feb. 11, 1910, the son of Joe and Mary Kuncy Stanker. He moved to Wyoming with his family when he was young and was raised in this area where he worked on various farms.

He served in the Armed Forces during World War II. His retirement years were spent in Wheatland.

He is survived by three brothers, Ed of Wheatland, Frank of Scottsbluff, Nebr. and Joe of Alaska, and by a sister, Kate Norvell of Wheatland.

A memorial in his name has been established to the Catholic Church Building Fund.

Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
