

Services for Lucie Hildegard (Kluge) Steeley, 83, who died April 6, 1987 in Wheatland, were held Friday, April 10, at 10 a.m. in the Trinity Lutheran Church with Pastor Randy Golder officiating.

Born in Dresden, Germany, December 13, 1903, Lucie was the daughter of Karl Alwin and Doris (Kahle) Kluge. She enjoyed painting and attended art school for two years. She also enjoyed mountain hiking.

She left East Germany to come to the United States in 1960, becoming a citizen in 1963. She married Henry Steeley and moved to this area in 1970. During the recent past she has been a resident at the Nursing Wing in the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital.

She is survived by a daughter, Iris Kunert of Erfurt, East Germany, and two grandchildren.
