

STEELEY, RHONDA LOUISE  
April 23, 1959-March 24, 1986

Services for Rhonda Louise Steeley, 26, who died in Wheatland March 24, 1986, will be held in the Wheatland Bible Church at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, March 27, 1986, with Rev. Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Rhonda Steeley was born in Wheatland April 23, 1959, the daughter of Dwaine and Rhonda Steeley. She was raised in Wheatland and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1978. While in high school she was very active in rodeo and she excelled in barrel racing. She was runner-up for Miss Platte County Rodeo Queen in her junior year. When she was attending school she worked at Cactus Jack's Store and upon graduation, she accepted a position with Dr. David Halsey as receptionist in his office. She later worked in an appliance store in Torrington and for radio station Q98 in Cheyenne.

Ill health had confined her to her parents' home since October of 1981, but she kept active with her hobby, ceramics, which was beneficial and a joy to her. She was an excellent artist doing sketching and sculpture during her high school years.

She is survived by her parents, Dwaine and Dottie Steeley of Wheatland, two sisters, Beverly Orr of Old Town, Idaho, Rosanne Burnett of Wheatland; her maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Don Hitt, her great grandmother, Audrey C. Huffer, three nieces: Carrie Orr, Christa and Coni Lea Burnett and three nephews: Cody Burnett, Russell and Wade Orr.
