

STEVENS, AMASA HARMON  
May 17, 1876-April 22, 1960

Funeral services were held at Guernsey at 10 a.m. for Amasa Harmon Stevens who died at Torrington, April 22. He was born at Susquehanna, Pa. on May 17, 1876. Mr. Stevens was a retired farmer and railroad worker.

On August 14, 1901, he was married to Bertha May Campbell at Rantoul, Ill., and they came to Wyoming in 1914, living near La Grange, in Guernsey, and on the Wheatland Flats. It was while they lived near Wheatland that Mrs. Stevens passed away on May 17, 1937.

Survivors include four daughters, Mrs. Carric Vance Smyth of Hawk Springs, Helen A. Bibbey of Wheatland, Mrs. Ruby Morgan Rimmer of Torrington, and Mrs. Beulah Moore of Guernsey; four sons, John of Laramie, Gerald of Guernsey, James of Pine Bluffs, Roderick of Los Angeles, Calif.; 24 grandchildren and 37 great grandchildren.
