LLEWELLYN ANDERSON STOFFLET

Services for L. A. Stofflet, 90, who died June 13 in Casper were held at 10:30 yesterday in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Tom Clark and Lloyd Wilson officiating.

Llewellyn Anderson Stofflet was born May 22, 1893, in Brooks County, Pa., the son of Franklin and Myra Jones Stofflet. He moved to Wyoming in 1919 and settled in Rock River where he cowboied at the Kite Ranch.

He homesteaded near the Hall Ranch near Garrett then went to work at the Dover Ranch. There he became acquainted with Violet E. Harwood whom he married in Wheatland, Nov. 17, 1930.

The couple worked at the Two Bar Ranch, then for the Twin Pine Ranch for a short time before moving to Denver where he worked for his father-in-law. In 1935 they returned to Wheatland, worked for the Swan Land and Cattle Company until 1958 when they retired to their own farm southwest of town where they remained until his death. He served his country as a soldier during World War I.

Survivors include his wife, two sons; Franklin Stofflet of Casper and L. L. "Red" Stofflet of Wheatland, a sister Frances, six grandchildren and three great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by two sisters and a brother.
