

STREED, JOSEPH ALBERT  
June 23, 1867-April 30, 1937

J.A. Streed, long time resident of Wheatland, and for many years, assessor for Platte county, died suddenly, Friday night, April 30, while visiting his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Jack Grey at Fruitland, Idaho. The body was returned to Wheatland Tuesday.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday afternoon from the Watson & Dennis Home for Funerals. Rev. Underwood and Rev. Duncan had charge of the services, and interment made in the Wheatland cemetery.

Joseph Albert Streed was born at Cambridge, Ill., June 23, 1867 and passed away from this life April 30, 1937, at the age of 69 years, 10 months and 1 week.

Mr. Streed was a member of the Odd Fellows and Masonic lodges, holding rank of Past Grand in the former lodge.

He was married to Lucy Bowling in October of 1889, and to this union were born four children. Three of these children survive him, a son Gerald having passed away in infancy. Mrs. Lucy Streed passed away about eleven years ago.

Mr. Streed moved into this community from Marshalltown, Iowa in 1909, and has lived most of the time since then in Platte County.

On Jan. 9, 1927, Mr. Streed married Mrs. Margaret M. Cotton in Wheatland.

Besides his widow, Mrs. Margaret M. Streed, he is survived by his two daughters, Mrs. Dasie Grey of Fruitland, Idaho and Mrs. Lenora Peters of Wheatland, and one son, Lloyd of Wheatland and several grandchildren. Also surviving are two sisters, Mrs. W.B. Shirey, Ann Arbor, Mich. and Mrs. Walter Shirey, Muncie, Ind, and a brother, Luther Streed, Galesburg, Ill.

Mr. Streed had a host of friends in this community, who will miss the warm cheery greeting
