

STRICKLER, JAMES FRANKLIN

January 11, 1922-June 24, 1926

Master James Franklin Strickler, son of Mr. and Mrs. L.M. Strickler, died Thursday, June 24, after a short illness and was buried Saturday in the Wheatland cemetery. The funeral was held at 2 p.m. Saturday from the Baptist church, Rev. R.L. Stratton performing the ceremony. His grandfather, Frank P. Marlow, and his aunt and uncle, Mr. and Mrs. J.A. Johnston came from Denver to attend the funeral.

The little boy was born Jan. 11, 1922, being four years, five months and 13 days old at the time of his death. Two of the Strickler children were taken ill at the same time, leading to the belief that ptomaine or similar food poisons may have been responsible. The sister is recovering.
