

STRICKLER, LUTHER MARION
April 2, 1893-February 2, 1966

Luther Marion Strickler, a resident of Wheatland since 1919, succumbed in the Platte County Memorial Hospital February 2, 1966 after a very brief illness. Mr. Strickler was born in Bolckow, Mo. on April 2, 1893 and married Ella Maye Marlow on April 9, 1919 in King City, Mo. The Stricklers homesteaded in the Wheatland area that year.

Mr. Strickler was employed as a meat cutter for many years, and retired from West Side Grocery in 1958. He was a member of the IOOF, VFW, Christian Church and was a veteran of World War I.

Many friends share the loss with the surviving family members: his wife, Ella Maye, and daughter, Mary Lillian Howard, both of Wheatland; son, Robert D. Strickler of Casper; daughter, Mrs. Annesta Zee Parr of Anchorage, Alaska; brother, Lewis Strickler, Rosendale, Mo.; sister, Mrs. Don C. Dougan, Hamburg, Ia., 11 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.

Services will be conducted by Mr. Dale Scheffler of the Christian church at 2:00 on Saturday. Military and IOOF honors will be held at the graveside in the local cemetery.
