

STUGART, ADAM
September 8, 1900-June 1, 1966

Adam Stugart, a Wheatland resident since 1942, succumbed at DePaul Hospital in Cheyenne, June 1, 1966 following a brief illness. He was born in Russia on Sept. 8, 1900 to Adam and Katherine Walter Stugart. Mr. Stugart was a veteran of World War II, serving with the Army from 1942-44. He was in the automobile repair business at the time of his death.

Survivors include four brothers, Alexander of Wheatland, Pete of Windsor, Colo., William of Ft. Collins, Colo. and Donald of Denver, Colo.; sisters, Mrs. Mary Befus and Mrs. Anna Folkers, both of Longmont, Colo. And Mrs. Katherine Lauck of Wheatland.
