

Helen Stump

Graveside services for Helen L. Stump, 74, who died in Sacramento, Calif., Sept. 13, 1987, will be held in the Wheatland Cemetery at 1 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 17 with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Helen Stump was born in Carrot, Neb., April 21, 1913, the daughter of Charles and Viola Mae Hartman. She moved with her family to Wheatland as a child and attended Wheatland schools, graduating from high school here in 1931. She worked as a waitress in the area until 1943 when she moved to Winnemucca, Nev. In 1961 she moved to Sacramento where she worked as a waitress until ill health forced her retirement. She passed away in the Christian Convalescent Hospital in Sacramento.

She is survived by nephews Earl L. Southworth of Whittier, Calif., and Dean E. Southworth of Widefield, Colo.

Besides her parents she was preceded in death by a sister, Mabel Hartman Phelps of Nampa, Idaho.
