

STUMPF, CLARENCE R.
January 14, 1908-June 28, 1975

Former Wheatland Times publisher, Clarence Stumpff died Saturday, June 28, 1975, at the age of 67 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Private services were held Tuesday, July 1, 1975, at the Schrader Chapel with the Rev. George Tritchler presiding. Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

A resident here in Wheatland since 1937, Mr. Stumpff was born in Hays Center, Nebraska January 14, 1908. He married Kathleen Carter in Fullerton, Nebraska July 19, 1934. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

Mr. Stumpff was the publisher of the Wheatland Times, now the Platte County Record Times, from 1938 to 1959 with the exception of 1 ½ years spent farming. A member of the United Church of Christ, he was very interested in the welfare of the community. He was also very interested in sports.

In death, he is survived by his wife Kathleen of Wheatland; two daughters, Mrs. L.B. (Sharon) Kreps of Sunnymead, Calif. and Mrs. Kurt (Cindy) Browall of Sioux Falls, So. Dak.; one brother, Chester of Grand Island, Nebraska; two sisters, Mrs. Ethel Hartcorn of Ft. Collins, Colo. and Mrs. Nina Lesser of Alhambra, Calif.; and four grandchildren.
