

SUTHERLAND, ALEXANDER DUNCAN

May 16, 1850-March 20, 1933

Alexander Duncan Sutherland died here Monday night at half past eleven o'clock. Mr. Sutherland, was born in Monticello, Iowa, May 16, 1850, eighty-two years and ten months ago. He came to Wyoming about four ago and has since made his home with Mr. and Mrs. Frank Sutherland. He suffered a stroke of paralysis March 14<sup>th</sup> and his death followed March 20<sup>th</sup>. His wife, formerly Lavina Livingston, died fourteen years ago the 21<sup>st</sup> of this month. Two sons, Frank of Wheatland and Fred B. of Filer, Idaho, and several grandchildren survive. He was of a cheery nature, enjoying life to the full, making many friends since he came to make his home here.

Funeral services, conducted by Rev. Kitch, were held at the Lyla Watson Funeral Home and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
