

SWANSON, DOROTHY E. JOHNSON

August 2, 1919-May 10, 1977

Funeral services for Dorothy Swanson will be held Thursday, May 12, 1977 at 10:30 a.m. from the Schrader-Prell Chapel in Wheatland. Rev. Tom Peacock will officiate at the services. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Swanson passed away at her home Tuesday, May 10, 1977, at the age of 57. She was born August 2, 1919 in Wheatland and was raised in Iowa Center Flats graduating from high school there. She attended the University of Wyoming and received her teaching certificate. She taught rural school on Laramie Peak prior to her marriage to Raymond in 1941. Mrs. Swanson and her husband farmed and ranched in Chugwater until their retirement in 1975. After his death July 21, 1976, she made her home in Wheatland.

In death she is survived by two sons, Derek of Wheatland and Kim of Casper; her mother, Lora Johnson; one brother, Phillip Johnson, of Cheyenne; two sisters, Elsie Sneesby of Casper and Nancy Pappas of Bayard, Nebr.; and one grandchild. She was preceded in death by her husband and her father, Arthur Johnson, January 3, 1976.
