May 19, 1907-July 21, 1976

Raymond Swanson of Chugwater passed away Wednesday, July 21, 1976 after an extended illness at the Casper Memorial Hospital at the age of 69. Rev. Tom Peacock conducted the funeral services at the Schrader-Prell Chapel Saturday, July 24, 1976. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Ernie Wilkins, Derald Peterson, Lon David, John Chasteen, Willard Baker and Eugene Penick served as pallbearers. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
