

5-31 GALE GORDON SWEDBERG 1986

Services for Gale Gordon Swedberg, 29, who died in San Bernadino, Calif. May 31, 1986, were held Saturday, June 7, at 2:00 P.M. in the Wheatland Bible Church, Wheatland, with Pastor Delbert Dick officiating.

Born June 14, 1956, in LaCrosse, Wisc., Gale was the son of Gordon and Betty Swedberg. He moved with his family to Clinton, Wisc., where he spent his early childhood, then later moved to Iowa Falls, Iowa, where he graduated from high school in the spring of 1975.

He and Elsie Kate Meyer were married February 14, 1975. He then served in the Marine Corps for 4 years, returning to civilian life in Broadus, Mont., where he worked for a phone company. He later worked as an instrumentation technician for a phone company in Glendive, Mont.

He moved to California to become associated with his brother in a construction business in 29 Palms. He died as a result of burns sustained in a construction accident.

Besides his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Gordon Swedberg of Wheatland, he is survived by his wife Elsie Swedberg of 29 Palms, a son Richard, two daughters, Katherine and Elizabeth, one brother, David Swedberg of 29 Palms, two sisters, Karen Cox of 29 Palms and Paulette Weber of Milwaukee, Wisc.

A memorial in his name has been established to the Shriner's Burns Institute of the United States.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
