

TATE, MAE INEZ MILLER
December 28, 1890-October 20, 1953

Services for Mrs. Mae Inez Tate, wife of Edwin O. Tate, who died October 20 at a local hospital following a brief illness, will be held at the Methodist church Friday at 2:00 o'clock. The Rev. J.B. Milstead and the Rev. Howard Rice were in charge of the services.

Mrs. Tate had been a Wheatland resident for nine years, the family home being the Cherry Hill farm southeast of town. She was born in Brasher, Mo. December 28, 1890, and lived on a homestead east of Glendo 36 years ago.
