

# Gregory Todd Taylor

Gregory Todd Taylor, 46, passed away from injuries in a car accident on Sunday, May 15, near Wheatland.

Gregory Taylor was born at the Balboa Naval Hospital in San Diego, Calif. on Nov. 7, 1969 to Gary L. and Judith Ann (Breen) Taylor.
