

TAYLOR, W.H.
July 10, 1851-May 26, 1928

W.H. Taylor died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. E.E. Vian, west of Wheatland, Saturday, May 26. Mr. Taylor at the time of his death was 77 years of age and had resided in the Wheatland vicinity for about five years. He is survived by four children, two brothers, one sister and 16 grandchildren. The funeral was held Monday afternoon at the Watson Mortuary Funeral Chapel with Rev. H.E. Shepherd preaching the funeral sermon and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.

W.H. Taylor was born in Fulton county, Ill. July 10th, 1851. He came to Iowa in 1852 where he lived until grown manhood. In early life he united with the Presbyterian church. In 1879 he was united in marriage to Mrs. Sophronia L. Smith. To this union were born five children, John Taylor, Everett, Wash., Mrs. Alvah Browning of Lee's Summit, Mo., Mrs. E.E. Vian of Wheatland, with whom he has made his home for the last five years, and Bessie Taylor who died in infancy. His wife departed this life some thirteen years past. He also leaves to mourn his loss one sister, Mrs. May Ewing of Wheatland, and two brothers, T.A. Taylor of Des Moines, Ia. and Robert Taylor of Omaha, Nebr., 16 grandchildren and a host of friends.
