

Dr. Teal Dies Here Thursday

An orthopedic surgeon, who practiced medicine in Cheyenne from 1946 to 1953, died yesterday at Memorial hospital.

Dr. Philip R. Teal maintained an office here from 1946 to 1953. Since 1955, he had been in practice in Wheatland.

Dr. Teal was born Nov. 28, 1906, at Wheatland. He was a veteran of World War II.

After leaving Cheyenne, Dr. Teal was on the staff of the Veterans Hospital at Fargo, N. D., for two years, from 1953 to 1955.

Dr. Teal was a member of the Presbyterian church.

He and the former Eleanor T. Smalley were married Sept. 3, 1955, at Wheatland.

Besides his wife, he is survived by a son, Philip R. Teal Jr. of Burns, Ore.; a daughter, Phyllis; two step-children, John J. Smalley of Laramie and Martha Ann Smalley of Wheatland; and four grandchildren.

Also surviving are his father, Dr. Frederick F. Teal of Lincoln; and a brother and sister, Dr. Fritz F. Teal and Mrs. Dorothy Odgen of Lincoln, Neb.
