

TERMAN, ALICE GRACE SAPPINGTON

March 30, 1877-June 5, 1953

Funeral services were held on Monday afternoon at 2:00 p.m. at the Congregational church for Mrs. Alice Grace Terman of Wheatland, a resident of the town since 1909. Mrs. Terman succumbed at her home on Friday, June 5, after a short illness.

She was the widow of the late Frank Terman, who passed away here several years ago. Born in Allen county, Ind., March 30, 1877, Mrs. Terman came with her family to Wheatland in 1909, where Mr. Terman was employed at the Farmers Mercantile for many years.
