

TERMAN, FRANKLIN ALONZO

June 4, 1873-June 16, 1940

F.A. Terman, long time Wheatland resident, passed away at his home in Wheatland on Sunday of last week following a long illness.

Mr. Terman came to this community from Indiana thirty-one years ago where he has made his home.

Franklin Alonzo Terman was born June 4, 1873, at Larwill, Indiana, son of William and LaNora Harrison Terman. Was married to Alice Grace Sappington at Larwill, Indiana, September 4, 1895. He leaves his wife, Mrs. Terman, and three daughters, Mrs. Fred C. Rossow of Broken Bow, Nebraska, Mrs. H.J. Houseworth of Lander, Wyoming, and Mrs. Donald Collins of Wheatland, and two sons, Beryl Terman of Casper, Wyoming and Ted Terman of Montrose, Colorado. Seven grandchildren and a sister, Mrs. Nellie Beard of South Whitley, Indiana. He moved to this community from Indiana 31 years ago. Services were held Tuesday at 2 p.m. from the Congregational church with Reverend L.W. Flenner officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with Watson and Dennis Funeral Home in charge.

Death came quietly at the Terman home.

Houseworth of Lander, Wyo.; Mrs. Donald Collins, Wheatland, and two sons Beryl of Casper and Ted of Montrose, Colorado and seven grandchildren.

One sister Mrs. Nellie Beard lives at South Whitley, Indiana.

After moving to Wheatland Mr. Terman worked in the mercantile business until illness forced him to retire. He has been an invalid since 1929.

Funeral services will be held this afternoon (Tues.) at 2 from the Congregational church with Rev. L.W. Flenner officiating. Interment will be made at the Wheatland cemetery.
