

THOMPSON, JESSIE MABLE DUNHAM

May 31, 1893-July 22, 1930

Mrs. Jessie M. Thompson, wife of J.E. Thompson and a resident of Wheatland for 15 years, passed away after an illness of 1 ½ years on Tuesday. Her condition had been very serious for some time and while the end was expected by those close to her, it came as a shock to her many friends.

Jessie Mable Dunham was born May 31, 1893, in Barber County, Kansas, being 37 years, 1 month and 21 days old at the time of her death. She came to Wheatland 15 years ago and was married to J.E. Thompson, June 3rd, 1917. To this union two daughters were born, Martha Irene, 11 years, and Gladys Wanda, 10 years. She became a Christian at the age of 11 years and joined the United Brethren Church, after her marriage she joined the Wheatland Baptist church.

Besides her husband and daughters, she is survived by her father and mother, Mr. and Mrs. Willis Dunham who live east of Wheatland; four sisters, Mrs. Minnie Sibert, Mrs. Louis Michaelis, and Mrs. Donly Curtis, and Mrs. Addis Carver, of Boone, Ia.; two brothers, Roy and John Dunham of Wheatland.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Baptist church with Cecil V. Smith, pastor of the Christian church performing the last rites. Burial will take place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge of the arrangements.
