

THRASHER, AUGUSTA LEE HARNBERGER

August 14, 1892-September 11, 1969

Funeral services for Augusta Lee Thrasher, 77, were held Sat., Sept. 13, at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel. Rev. James E. More officiated and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
