

THRASHER, ELISHA TRUE
August 27, 1853-August 12, 1945

Funeral services were held in the Schrader chapel at 10 a.m. Tuesday for E.T. Thrasher, 92, who passed away in the Wheatland General hospital Sunday, following a long illness. Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiated.

Elisha True Thrasher was born August 27, 1853 in Delaware, Ohio, and had been a resident of this community since 1923. He was the former owner of the general store and filling station on the Laramie Highway, now owned by K.V. Howe. He was preceded in death by his wife and two daughters.

Survivors include two sons, M.A. Thrasher and Charles W. Thrasher; two grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

Pallbearers included Charles Schreyer, K.V. Howe, Samuel Goit, Charles Randall, Asa Covington, and Dr. W.E. West. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. The Schrader Funeral home was in charge of arrangements.
