

TILLMAN, REX ARNOLD
December 8, 1938-June 9, 1960

Funeral services were held on Thursday afternoon at four o'clock at the Schrader Chapel for Rex Arnold Tillman, 22, who passed away suddenly at the Rapid City, S.D. hospital Monday, June 9, 1960.

The deceased was born in Keystone, Nebr., Dec. 8, 1938, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert W. Tillman. He lived in Wheatland in 1955-56 and attended the local school and graduated from the Douglas high school in 1956. He entered the Navy in 1957 and served for two years. He has been employed as an iron worker for the Adams Construction Co. in Rapid City, S.D.
