**Erwin A. Tisch
Passes Away
At Cheyenne**

APRIL 29, 1944

Funeral services for Erwin A. Tisch 66, who died suddenly at Memorial hospital Saturday following a heart attack was held at 1 p. m. Wednesday at the Schrader funeral home in Cheyenne.

The Rev. Raiph Veit officiated and burial will be made in Wheatland.

Tisch suffered the heart attack Saturday noon at his home and was removed to the hospital. He had been ill since Easter but was not taken to the hospital until Saturday.

Manager of the City Loan company at 2116 Carey, Tisch was an oldtime resident of Wyoming and had lived in Cheyenne for the past 19 years.

He came to Cheyenne from Wheatland where he and his brothers operated the first drug store. At that time he was active in both banking and ranching.

Survivors include his wife, Anna, and a daughter, Helen Louise.

Tisch was a member of the Wyoming Consistory, the Wheatland Blue lodge, the Woodmen of the World, the Cheyenne Chamber of Commerce, the Isaak Walton league, and the Congregational church.
